



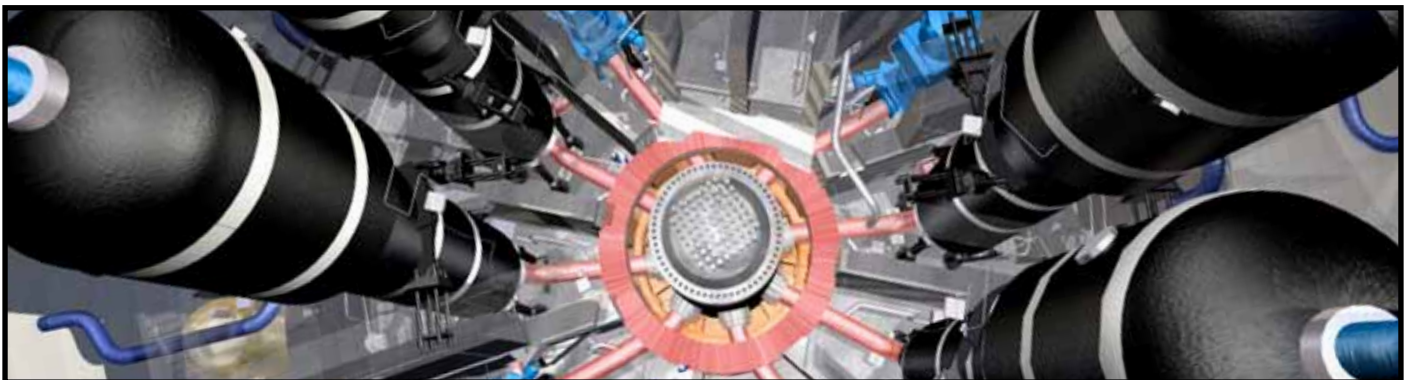

Understanding nuclear quality standards



How can manufacturers who want to enter the civil nuclear supply chain demonstrate that they can meet the required standards?

The latest event from the AMRC's **Advanced Manufacturing Forum** provides an introduction to the quality demands of the nuclear manufacturing supply chain.

Energy companies are preparing to invest £40 billion in new nuclear power plant in the UK. To enter their supply chains, engineering manufacturers need to be able to demonstrate that they meet industry quality standards and contractual requirements.

But quality and accreditation can be a confusing area for companies entering the nuclear manufacturing market.

Common questions include:

- At what level of the supply chain do nuclear standards apply?
- Do I need to meet ASME or RCC-M code requirements, neither, or both?
- How do they compare to standards in other sectors?
- How can I prove that I meet requirements?
